



New Life Nyambene rescues abandoned street and destitute children in Kenya

The children have been traumatised by starvation, neglect and abuse; and over time we nurture them back into physical and emotional health. We provide them with food, healthcare, clothes and protection, but above all, with a supportive community who give them love, hope and purpose. We pay for them to attend local schools, and when they are old enough, vocational training colleges or further education.

New Life Nyambene is a partnership between Kenya and the UK. The Children's Home in the Nyambene Hills is managed and run by a dedicated team of Kenyans. In the UK, a group of volunteers supports the Home by raising funds for the children.
